NEW COMPUTER ASSISTED MASS APPRAISAL (CAMA) SYSTEM BEING INSTALLED

Our office will be converting to a new CAMA System on February 12, 2018.

As part of the transition, all data changes (*splits, combinations, ownership changes, mailing and/or situs address changes, etc.*) not processed by January 26, 2018 will not be reflected on the tax roll until at least March 2018.

IMPROVEMENTS TO THE PROPERTY APPRAISER WEBSITE COMING SOON!

Scheduled for late March / early April 2018.

Weekly data updates will continue through January 26, 2018. After this date, while we are transitioning to our new CAMA system and applying all the new improvements to our website, we will not be doing the weekly updates. We expect to be back to the normal weekly updates in April 2018.

The old mapping applications, PALMS and MapIT will be retired. The Map Kiosk will be removed from our site; however, it will be available through the main County website as part of their Zoning Search feature.
